In case the sufficient/required number of candidates are not available in any of the respective reserved category, then the vacancies left unfilled in such reserved category may be filled by the Hon'ble Committee from amongst the candidates available in unreserved category, subject to their availability, in terms of Explanation to Rule 7 of the Punjab Subordinate Courts Establishment (Recruitment and General Conditions of Service) Rules, 1997.

The salary, pay and allowances of the selected candidates will be governed as per the latest rules and instructions adopted by the Government of Punjab and adopted for the Subordinate Courts of Punjab from time to time.

2. **QUALIFICATION**

The applicant should possess a degree of Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science or equivalent thereto from a recognized university and must have proficiency in operation of computers (Word Processing and Spread Sheets).

He/she should have passed matriculation examination with Punjabi as one of the compulsory or elective subject or any other equivalent examination in Punjabi Language. Candidates who have not passed matriculation with Punjabi as one of the compulsory or elective subject or any other equivalent examination in Punjabi Language at matriculation level can apply however, they would be required to pass the same within the probation period, if selected, failing which their appointment shall stand cancelled.

Note:- The applicant, who possesses degree of graduation from any stream i.e. Arts, Commerce, Science or Computer is eligible.

<u>The applicant should fulfil the condition of qualification on the last date of receipt of applications i.e. 07.09.2021.</u>

3. DISQUALIFICATION

No Person :-

- a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or;
- b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person.

Shall be eligible for appointment to the service.

Provided that the Committee, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage may exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

4. MODE OF SELECTION

The candidates will have to qualify the English Shorthand Test and its Transcription at the speed of 80 W.P.M. and 20 W.P.M. respectively. The candidates will also have to qualify a Computer Proficiency Test.

The Hon'ble Central Recruitment Committee reserves the right to decide the permissible percentage of mistakes in the transcription of English Shorthand Test and permissible marks required to qualify the Spreadsheet exam depending upon the number of vacancies and number of candidates available.

It is clarified that said Computer Proficiency Test is mandatory but the same is of qualifying nature only and its marks or performance will not be counted towards final merit which will be based only upon the performance in the English Shorthand Test and its Transcription

The number of candidates as decided by Hon'ble Central Recruitment Committee, who qualify the English Shorthand Test and Computer Proficiency Test, will be called for checking of original testimonials/interaction.

Thereafter, Select List of the qualified candidates will be prepared strictly on the basis of merit in the English Shorthand Test & its transcription. Name of eligible candidate (s) higher in merit would be recommended for appointment as per the number of vacancies to be filled. In case, if two or more candidates have obtained same marks, then the candidate elder in age among the same scorers be kept higher in merit.

5. <u>NATIONALITY, DOMICILE & CHARACTER OF PERSONS</u>

As per Punjab Subordinate Courts Establishment (Recruitment and General Conditions of Service) Rules, 1997.

6. <u>SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS</u>

The decision of the Hon'ble Central Recruitment Committee in all matters relating to acceptance or rejection of an application, eligibility/suitability of the applicants, mode/criteria for selection etc. shall be final and binding on the applicants. The Hon'ble Central Recruitment Committee may shortlist the candidates at any stage of the recruitment process on the basis of some criteria. 7. FOR REGULAR GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE:

The applicants who are already serving in Government/Semi Government/PSU/Corporations/Boards must submit the undertaking to the effect that if he/she will qualify the recruitment process then he/she have to submit the original NOC at the time of checking of original testimonials/ interaction, otherwise such candidates would not be taken into consideration for Recruitment purpose and his/her candidature is liable to be rejected out rightly by the Hon'ble Central Recruitment Committee.

8. <u>E-ADMIT CARD:</u>-

E-Admit Cards of provisionally eligible applicants will be uploaded on the website. Applicants will also receive E-mails/SMS in this regard. Admit Cards shall not be sent by post. Mere issuance of provisional E-Admit Card does not imply that applicant has fulfilled all the eligibility conditions given in the advertisement and application is subject to subsequent scrutiny and the application can be rejected, if the applicant is found to be not fulfilling the eligibility conditions at any point of time.

The applicants shall paste his/her photograph, duly attested by a Gazatted Officer/Self-attested on the E-Admit card. The photograph must be same as uploaded by the applicant in his/her online application. 11. DATE OF EXAMINATION

The examination is likely to be conducted in the month of **November/December**, **2021**. The exact date will be notified on the website of S.S.S.C. (<u>www.sssc.gov.in</u>) and candidates are advised to regularly visit the website. However, the month of examination may be changed as per administrative exigencies.

12. <u>IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS</u>

- i) Applicants are advised to visit the website of S.S.S.C. and check their E-mail accounts (inbox as well as spam box) regularly for updates regarding Exam, Result and other important information. Unnecessary correspondence with S.S.S.C. should be avoided.
- **ii**) A candidate, whether he/she belongs to General or reserve category, can submit only one application for a particular category. In case, more than one application are received, his/her all applications may be rejected.
- iii) The conditions of employment/service, reservation and all other conditions of recruitment not covered in the above Notice shall be regulated as per the instructions of the Punjab Subordinate Courts Establishment (Recruitment and General Conditions of Services) Rules, 1997 as amended time to time.

14. HOW TO APPLY ONLINE

GUIDLINES/INSTRUCTIONS RELATING TO ONLINE APPLICATION FORM

Candidates are advised to read the detailed Advertisement before filling up the Application.

Candidates are strictly directed to check whether their Final Online application **Status** Completed Pending login link is or by on the i.e. http://www.sssc.gov.in/candidatefinalsubmitpb.aspx, completion of online after Registration

(A) <u>Pre-Requisites for Online Registration</u>

Applicants are required to have a valid personal active E-mail ID as all the information regarding recruitment process will be sent on their recorded E-Mail ID throughout the process. Applicants must give a valid Mobile number, as all the SMSs during the process will be sent on that number.

Applicant must ensure that he/she has scanned image files of his/her **latest passport** size coloured PHOTOGRAPH (Size 100 x 120 pixels) & SIGNATURE (Size 160 x 70 pixels) with clear background in PC/Pen-drive/other soft media for immediate uploading it to the website alongwith application data.

Applicants are advised not to change their Mobile number/E-mail ID which they mentioned at the time of Registration. Applicants are also advised not to give mobile number/E-mail ID of unknown person/stranger to avoid any future complication. - iii. Click on the button Online Registration for new user. Fill the registration form with all the required details.
- iv. Every successful registration will be allotted a unique Registration ID and Password, which will be intimated to the applicant by way of e-mail on recorded Email ID as well as by SMS on his/her mobile phone. Applicants should ensure that Registration ID and Password have been delivered on mobile phone as well as on given E-mail ID. After getting the Registration ID and Password, applicant will be redirected to online payment page showing user details and application fee depending upon his/her category. By clicking on submit button, the applicant will be redirected to online payment gateway page. Candidates opting to pay through Card, Internet Banking and UPI facility will be directed to their respective sites. Follow instructions/steps on the respective sites. Candidate will receive SMS and Email after successful payment of his/her respective fee on registered Mobile No. and Email. Thereafter, Candidate will be redirected to Registration Step-II.
